

Harlowton City Council Minutes
September 22, 2015

A regular meeting of the Harlowton City Council held September 22, 2015 opened with the Pledge of Allegiance. Minutes of the September 8, 2015 meeting were approved as written.

John Anderson asked if Ian had checked with the state regarding the crosswalk electrical box in front of Midtown Market that now poses as a danger to pedestrians walking on the newly constructed sidewalks. Ian said he would discuss it with them.

Joe Brouillette had questions about the skimmer. Jeff Sell stated that the grant funds we are receiving for the clean-up of the round house area is also providing funding to fix the current skimmer.

Bob Jones was wondering about the fuel plume pumps in operation in town. Bryan Tomlinson stated that the current pumps have not detecting any fuel to pump for a few months.

Resolution 2015-7 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HARLOWTON, MONTANA, PROVIDING FOR THE ANNUAL TAX LEVIES FOR THE CITY OF HARLOWTON, MONTANA, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2015-2016 was read. Bryan Tomlinson made a motion to approve resolution 2015-7. John Anderson seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

Ian Reed, city superintendent reported that the chip sealing equipment was not working properly yet. The C Avenue sidewalk project is progressing. The marked light poles in town have been discussed with Pete Heal (NorthWestern Energy). Representatives from USDA, PEC, Dick Anderson Construction, and RPA were on site September 10 for the 11 month warranty inspection on the sewer rehabilitation project from 2014. There were no warranty issues outstanding.

The next council meeting will be October 13, 2015 at 7:00 pm in the city hall.

Jeff Sell stated he would be out of the state October 9-12, 2015.

Bob Jones made a motion to pay the bills, checks #19954 to #19966 from the September 5 through September 18 claims. John Anderson seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.
