There was no public comment.

Review of the draft rules and regulations governing utility services commenced at section 9 with the following changes, deletions, or additions noted:

Rate, charges and fees for Section 9 will be reviewed after the remainder of the rules and regulations.

Section 10

10.1 strike “for commercial accounts” and “and all municipal water meters for domestic accounts at least bi-monthly”. The city of Harlowton reads all water meters once per month.

10.2.4 add “if needed” so it reads “Test, if needed, all 5/8-inch...”

10.4.1 Bob will do additional research for requirements for back flow devices.

10.9 strike last two sentences of last paragraph. The City furnishes meters up to 1 inch...

Kathie asked if enforcement and penalties will be included in the ordinance or if such items need to be included within the rules and regulations. Rob suggested that Karen Hammel would have to determine that but he believes it will be part of the ordinance.

No further review took place.
