

Harlowton Public Hearing Minutes – HB355
March 12, 2024

The Harlowton City Council opened a Public Hearing at 6:45 pm at the Harlowton City Hall. The Council held the hearing to inform the public of HB 355 State-Local Infrastructure Partnership Act.

Mayor Paul Otten informed the public of HB355 and the projects that the Councilmembers unanimously decided to utilize the funds for.

The City will be applying for the grant, with a total amount of \$93,000 being allotted to the City. The purpose of the grant is to allow Municipalities to make necessary improvements, including roadways, water, and sewer systems.

The Council decided to utilize the funds to chip seal select roads throughout Harlowton. The main road being Central Ave. The estimated cost for this project would be about \$65,000. The remaining \$28,000 the Council would like to utilize towards the transfer station to allow for more dumpsters, and potentially more free dump days.
