PROHIBITION OF CERTAIN BUSINESSES AND TRADES AS NUISANCES

5.16.020 Demonstrations and Displays. The business, trade or profession of conducting upon the streets, sidewalks or alleys of the City of Harlowton, or upon vacant lots adjoining any street or alley within the City of Harlowton, a public or private demonstration or display of goods, wares and merchandise for sale is allowed during business hours. After business hours displays will be removed. Displays on sidewalks will be placed to cover no more than 40 percent of the distance from building front to curb, leaving 60% of sidewalk available for pedestrians. No permanent displays allowed.

5.16.030 Penalty. Any person, persons, firm association or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in a sum of not less than twenty five dollars nor more than two hundred fifty dollars, together with cost of prosecution, or by imprisonment in the city jail for a period of time of not less than one days and not more than ten days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
