5.20.010 Peddling in City Without License. That from and after the passage of this ordinance, no person shall engage in peddling within the City of Harlowton, and no peddler shall follow such calling without first having obtained a license to do so from the city.

5.20.020 The Term "Peddler". The term "peddler" for the purpose of this ordinance shall be construed to include all solicitors, peddlers, hawkers, itinerant photographers, itinerant merchants and transient vendors, including all persons, co-partnerships and corporation, principals and agents engaged or employed in the business of retailing to consumers by going from consumer to consumer, either on the streets, sidewalks, or alleys of the City of Harlowton, or upon vacant lots adjoining any street or alley within the City of Harlowton or to their place of residence or employment, and there soliciting, selling or offering to sell, or exhibiting for sale by sample, by catalogue or otherwise or taking for future delivery of any goods, wares or merchandise, or for service to be performed in the future. A consumer is one who uses and by using destroys the value of the article purchased.

5.20.030 Application for License. For the purpose of defraying the expenses of regulation under this ordinance, every person, co-partnership or corporation desiring to engage in the occupation of peddling in the in the City of Harlowton, must make application for such licenses in approved manner to the City Clerk, and pay said Clerk the sum of \$10.00 per day, or \$35.00 per week, or \$100.00 per year to conduct such business.

Chapter 10

REGULATION OF THE WATER SUPPLY OF THE CITY

10.1.1. The purpose of this ordinance is to regulate the water supply of the City of [City Name] and to ensure that the water supply is sufficient to meet the needs of the City and its residents.

10.1.2. The City shall have the right to acquire, own, operate, and maintain any and all water supply facilities, including but not limited to, water treatment plants, water distribution systems, and water conservation programs.

10.1.3. The City shall have the right to regulate the use of water supply facilities and to enforce any and all rules, regulations, and ordinances relating to the use of water supply facilities.

5.20.070 Interfering with U.S. to Regulate Commerce. Nothing contained in this act is intended to operate as to interfere with the power of the United States to regulate commerce between the states as such power is defined by the Supreme Court of the United States.

5.20.080 Penalty. That any person who shall violate any of the terms of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof, be fined in a sum not less than \$75.00 nor more than \$200.00 for each and every offense.

5.20.090 Farm to Market. No peddlers license shall be required of persons marketing farm produce raised in Wheatland County to individuals or businesses within the City.

5.20.100 Permanent Residents. All permanent residents of the City of Harlowton, are excluded from the provisions of this ordinance.
