7.08.010 Burning Without Using Paper Burner - Penalty. That any person, persons or corporation, who shall within the fire limits of the City of Harlowton, burn without using a paper burner or incinerator, as herein specified, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not less than sixty dollars (\$60.00) or more than three hundred dollars (\$300.00), or by imprisonment in the city jail not exceeding two months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

7.08.020 Description of Paper Burner. Any person, persons or corporation shall be allowed to burn paper or their refuse matter on the back part of any lot, providing a paper burner or incinerator of the following dimensions and specifications is used, inwhich said fire confined: The paper burner or incinerator shall be constructed of 5' high, with a cone top 12" high above the body: The top of the cone to be connected to same by a 12" collar, same to be covered with one quarter wire mesh and be spark proof; the bottom of the burner shall be reinforced with an iron band riveted on and there shall be suitable openings in the bottom of the burner to admit an air draft; a door 11x12 shall be placed near the top of said burner and shall be securely braced so that the same will not warp, which door shall be securely attached to the body of the incinerator with strong hinges and catches.
