### NUISANCE TO KEEP DOMESTIC LIVESTOCK IN CITY

8.04.010 Keeping of Some Animals a Nuisance. The keeping, housing, herding or penning up of any bull, cow, steer, heifer or calf, or any pigs, hogs, sows or swine, or any horses or mules, or any goats, sheep, or any fowl, or any non-domesticated animals within the city limits of the City of Harlowton, Montana, is hereby prohibited and declared to be a nuisance.

8.04.020 A Misdemeanor to Keep Some Animals Within City. The keeping, housing, herding or penning up of any bull, cow, steer, heifer or calf, or any pigs, hogs, sows or swine, or any horses or mules, or any goats, sheep, or any fowl, or any non-domesticated animals within the city limits of the City of Harlowton, Montana, is hereby declared to be a misdemeanor, and may be punished in accordance with this ordinance.

8.04.025 Special Provision for Keeping of Some Animals. Sections 8.04.010 and 8.04.020 are to be in effect throughout the year except during the July 3rd and 4th Parade and Rodeo and the Wheatland County Youth Fair, when such animals will be allowed within city limits during the duration of those events only if they are part of those exhibitions, and are kept within the designated ares.

8.04.030 Marshal & Police Authorized to Suppress Nuisance. The city marshal and police force of the City of Harlowton, Montana, are hereby authorized, approved, required and directed to suppress and to abate each nuisance as defined in Section 010 of this ordinance.

8.04.040 Penalties. Any person, persons or corporation convicted of perpetuating a nuisance or committing a misdemeanor as herein defined, shall upon conviction thereof be fined in a sum not less than ten dollars (\$10.00) and not more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) together with cost of proceedings, or by imprisonment in the city jail for not less than three (3) days and not more than thirty (30) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
