

Chapter 9.08

ABATEMENT OF NUISANCES

9.08.010 Unlawful to Dump Waste on Lots, Streets, etc..
It shall hereafter be unlawful for any person or persons to dump, place, deposit or empty any refuse matter, straw, hay, empty cans, waste clothing, garbage, waste paper, rags, old shoes, barb wire, baling wire, any smooth or covered wires, or other matters calculated to produce disease, trash or filth on any lot or lots, street or streets, or alleys within said city.

9.08.020 Unlawful to Obstruct any Streets or Avenues.
It shall hereafter be unlawful for any person or persons to make use of any of the streets or avenues of said city as standing places for vehicles of any kind of machinery in such number as to in any wise obstruct any of the streets or avenues of said city.

9.08.030 Unlawful to Cause any Nauseous Substance to Flow on Streets and Alleys. It shall hereafter be unlawful for any person or persons to cause or permit any nauseous, foul or putrid liquid or substance, or any liquid substance likely to become nauseous, foul, offensive, or putrid upon any premises, to be discharged, placed or thrown or to flow from or out of any premises into or upon any adjacent premises, or any public street or alley.

9.08.040 Unlawful to Commit a Public Nuisance. Any act or acts which would be a public nuisance under the common law are hereby each declared a public nuisance under the meaning of this ordinance. It shall hereafter be unlawful for any person or persons to commit a public nuisance within the City of Harlowton.

9.08.050 Removing Nuisance Within 24 Hours. Any person guilty of committing any nuisance and who shall fail to remove such within 24 hours after he or they shall have been notified so to do by the city marshal it shall then be the duty of the city marshal to have same removed.

9.08.060 Penalties. Any person or persons who shall violate any of the foregoing sections shall be deemed guilty of committing a misdemeanor and on conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not less than five dollars and not more than one hundred dollars and costs of prosecution.

9.08.070 Guilty Persons Liable for all Costs. Every person guilty of any nuisance shall be liable for all costs and expense of abating same, and said cost and expenses shall be taxed as a part of the cost and be recovered after the same shall have been ascertained and taxed as part of the judgment.
