

ORDINANCE NO. 01-2023 Chapter 10.46

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HARLOWTON, MONTANA,
AMENDING THE HARLOWTON MUNICIPAL CODE BY REVISING
SECTION 10.46.030 ALLOWING THE CITY COUNCIL TO CHANGE THE
COLOR OF NO PARKING ZONES UPON REQUEST FROM YELLOW TO
RED BY RESOLUTION UNLESS PROHIBITED BY LAW OR
REGULATION**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
HARLOWTON THAT:**

Section 1. That section 10.46.030 of the Harlowton, Montana City Code is amended in part so that the first paragraph of such section shall read as follows and the remaining subsections following these amendments shall remain unchanged:

Sec. 10.46.030 Non-Parking Zones

Any non-parking zones on U.S Highway 212 within the corporate limits of the City of Harlowton, Montana, and all non-parking zones on city streets as hereinafter provided shall be marked plainly by yellow painting upon the curb-way. Upon request the city may designate red painting on specific curb-ways or other areas unless otherwise prohibited by law or regulation. All non-parking zones on city streets may be restricted by appropriate resolution of the city council. That there is hereby established a NO PARKING ZONE on the southside of East Division street from Lots 11 and 12 in Block 23 of the Graves Second Addition extending west to the northeast corner of Lot 15 in block 24 of the Graves Second Addition to the City of Harlowton, Wheatland County, Montana. There is hereby established a NO PARKING ZONE on the west side of B Avenue N.E. in front of Lot 12 of Block 8 of the Van Cleve Addition to the City of Harlowton, Wheatland County, Montana. The above designated NO PARKING ZONES shall be subject to the following:

1. Parking shall be restricted to one-half hour before the morning school hours until one-half hour after school closing.
2. School buses shall be allowed to park in the No Parking Zones at any time for the purpose of loading or unloading.
3. There shall be designated within said No Parking Zones, areas to be plainly marked "loading and unloading" to be used for commercial vehicles and school lunch vehicles not to exceed fifteen (15) minutes.

Section 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be effective thirty (30) days after second reading and final adoption as provided by law.

Section 3. REPEALER. All resolutions, ordinances, and sections of the City Code inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the other provisions of this ordinance which may be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and, to this end, the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.
