Christopher Gentile from the Wheatland County Sheriff's Office had questions regarding when the new dog ordinance goes into effect. Kathie explained that it goes into effect on March 28, 2019 which is the required 30 days after the second reading and approval by the Harlowton City Council.

Discussions regarding the draft snow removal ordinance and resolution ensued. Officer Gentile asked about setting a ticket/bond price in the ordinance otherwise every infraction of this ordinance would have to go to city court judge for setting of fines. As Karen Hammel was not in attendance, Frank asked that further discussion be deferred until she could be consulted.

Discussion regarding hiring a city employee to do snow removal on city owned sidewalks and charge an assessment to the residents of Harlowton took place. Also discussed was putting out to bid the same project to local contractors/individuals, either city wide or bid by ward. City staff will try to work on some estimates of the costs.

Ordinance committee will suggest to full council to not proceed with the first reading of Ordinance 2-2019 regarding snow removal as there are too many unanswered questions right now. As resolution 2019-03 is related to said ordinance, Frank will recommend not proceeding with passing resolution 2019-03 tonight as well.
