DRIVING ON SIDEWALKS

10.54.010 Unlawful to Drive on Sidewalks. That any person who drives or propels an automobile or motor vehicle of any kind, bicycle or any other kind of a vehicle, to be driven or propelled within the corporate limits of the City of Harlowton, Montana, except on the streets and alleys thereof, shall be subject to a fine of not less than ten dollars (\$10.00), nor more than fifty dollars (\$50.00) and the costs of prosecution and shall be committed to jail until such fine and costs are paid at the rate of one day for each two dollars of said fine and costs.

10.54.020 A Misdemeanor for Violation. Every person, who within the limits of the City of Harlowton, shall ride or drive any horse, mule or other animal, buggy, wagon, bicycle, automobile or any other vehicle, on or along any sidewalk, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor.
