

## Chapter 5.08

### REGULATING REGISTRATION OF TENANTS IN TEMPORARY HOUSING

5.08.010 Keeping a Register. Every person, firm or corporation keeping, conducting, running or managing a hotel or lodging house, shall keep a register in which shall be entered the names of each and every person occupying any room or rooms in such hotel or lodging house with the number of the room or rooms occupied by such person, and it shall be the duty of such person, firm or corporation, and of the member of such firm and officers of such corporation running such hotel or lodging house to make such entry or to see that such entry is made in said register before such guest or lodger begins to occupy said room or rooms, and to cancel such registration immediately upon the vacation of the room or rooms.

5.08.020 Registration to be Open for Inspection. Such register shall be kept in a prominent place in the hotel or lodging house and shall be open to inspection of the public and the officers of the law at all times day and night.

5.08.030 Provisions not to Apply to Private Owners. The provisions of this ordinance shall not apply to the owners or occupants of private residences who shall rent rooms to persons from month to month.

5.08.040 Penalty. Every person, firm or corporation, or member of a firm or officer or manager of a corporation, who violates any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in a sum not less than ten dollars nor more than fifty dollars and the cost of prosecution, and shall be committed to jail until such fine and costs are paid at the rate of one day for each two dollars of said fine and costs.
