GARBAGE COLLECTION

7.40.010 Containers. It shall be the duty of every owner, occupant, tenant or lessee, or any of them individually, of any and every occupied building used for human habitation or business purposes within the City of Harlowton, to provide or cause to be provided, portable, washable, containers of not greater than thirty (30) gallon capacity, sufficient in number to hold all the garbage accumulating between periods of removal. Containers must be manufactured receptacles with attached lid. This ordinance is not intended to prevent the use of commercial dumpsters or other commercial-sized receptacles supplied by the hauling company which are designed to fit automatic garbage handling equipment.

7.40.020 Garbage Container Racks. Thirty (30) gallon containers (or smaller) as described above shall be kept in a rack or stand constructed of suitable material that shall be designed so that the bottom of the garbage containers shall be at least six inches, but not more than one foot, above the surface level of the alley or street.

7.40.030 Waste Material. Waste material too large to be collected by the city, such as refrigerators, stoves, car bodies and like items shall be transported to the city dump by the owner and deposited in the area of said city dump reserved for such items.

7.40.040 Penalty for Violation. Violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor and upon a plea of guilty, or upon conviction, a fine of not to exceed one hundred (\$100.00) dollars shall be imposed.
