
## Chapter 9.16

## REMOVAL OF SNOW AND ICE

- 9.16.010 Removal of Snow From Sidewalks. Every person or occupant of any house or other building and the owner or proprietor, lessee or person entitled to the possession of any vacant lot, and every person having charge of any church, jail or public hall or public building abutting on or adjoining upon any concrete or cement sidewalk within the City of Harlowton, shall during the time snow shall continue on the ground, by the hour of ten o'clock a.m., when necessary, clear the sidewalk in front of such house or other building, and in front of such lot, from snow and ice, and keep the same conveniently free there from during the day; and shall at all times keep said sidewalks free and clear from all dirt, filth and other obstructions and encumbrances, so as to allow citizens the free use of such sidewalks in an easy and commodious manner.
- 9.16.020 Failure to Remove Snow and Ice. Whenever any owner, proprietor, lessee or person entitled to the possession of any vacant lot, block or premises abutting upon any concrete or cement sidewalk within the City of Harlowton during the winter season and during the time snow shall continue on the ground, shall for the space of twenty-four hours, fail, refuse or neglect to clear the sidewalk in front of such vacant lot, block or premises from snow and ice, the chief of police of the City of Harlowton shall cause such snow and ice to be removed, and shall report the same, together with the varified voucher of the cost of such removal to the city council, and said costs shall be assessed upon the lot, block, or premises abutting upon said sidewalk. Such costs, if found to be correct by the city council, shall constitute a lien upon said property, and shall be collected as other special assessments are collected.



- 9.16.030 Penalties. Any person, persons, or corporation who shall interfere, or obstruct, or attempt to interfere or obstruct any employee of the city in carrying out the provisions of this ordinance, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in a sum not exceeding one hundred dollars, (\$100.00).
- 9.16.040 Remedy Providing for Clearing of Sidewalks. The remedy providing for the clearing of said sidewalks from snow and ice as provided in section 030 of this ordinance, shall be cumulative and additional to all other remedies provided by law or ordinance.
