

ORDINANCE NO. 1-2018

ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HARLOWTON, MONTANA, AMENDING CHAPTER 1.04 OF THE CITY OF HARLOWTON MUNICIPAL CODES CONCERNING PASSAGE OF ORDINANCES, TO REPEAL SECTIONS THEREIN.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the City Council has found that the existing Municipal Codes concerning the manner in which ordinances shall be passed should be repealed as they are inconsistent with or otherwise covered by statutes of the State of Montana; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that repeal of Sections 1.04.030, 1.04.040, 1.04.050, 1.04.080, 1.04.090, and 1.04.100 will address these issues, as provided below:

Section 1:

1.04.030: The City Council proposes that Section 1.04.030, entitled Ordinance in Effect, be repealed because it is inconsistent with and is otherwise covered by Montana Statutes.

1.04.040: The City Council proposes that Section 1.04.040, entitled Ordinance Adopted by Initiative, be repealed because it is inconsistent with Montana Statutes.

1.04.050: The City Council proposes that Section 1.04.050, entitled Publication of Ordinance, be repealed because it is inconsistent with and is otherwise covered by Montana Statutes.

1.04.080: The City Council proposes that Section 1.04.080, entitled Passing Ordinance by Council, be repealed because it is inconsistent with and is otherwise covered by Montana Statutes.

1.04.090: The City Council proposes that Section 1.04.090, entitled Title or Ordinance be repealed because it is covered by Montana Statutes.

1.04.100: The City Council proposes that Section 1.04.100, entitled Ordinance Vetoed by Mayor, be repealed because it is covered by Montana Statutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council, City of Harlowton, Montana, as follows:

Section 1: Action

Chapter 1.04, sections 1.04.030, 1.04.040, 1.04.050, 1.04.080, 1.04.090, and 1.04.100 are hereby repealed.

Section 2: Repealer

All resolutions, ordinances and sections of the City of Harlowton Municipal Code and Parts thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3: Severability







Section 4: Effective Date


